LLF's work in Multilingual Education

Resonating the spirit of the NEP 2020, LLF has always been committed to the formal use of children's home languages in the classrooms and has been a leading organization in the domain of multilingual education in the country.

To address the home-school language gap, LLF has been running a Multilingual Education (MLE) Program in 40 schools of Dungarpur, Rajasthan with children of grades 1, 2 and 3 since the beginning of 2019. The intervention also includes a comprehensive research component, focussed on developing critical understanding around some key issues related to multilingual education.

LLF also works in partnership with the NCERT, states education bodies and several eminent organizations on MLE policy and advocacy, developing and implementing courses and trainings, capacity building programs, making public goods and guidelines, animated videos etc.

Position Summary

The MLE expert will work in close collaboration with the MLE core team at LLF and be responsible for actively contributing to all the major MLE work areas like primary and secondary research, developing capacity building programs and courses for teachers and various education stakeholders, developing academic content for children, as well as national level policy and advocacy work.

The position is based out of the central office at Delhi and might require occasional travel to the field.



Key Responsibilities

- Do primary and secondary research to develop knowledge in the domain of MLE in Indian contexts
- Develop a range of online and offline capacity building programs, courses, workshops and trainings for teachers and education officials on MLE
- Conduct and implement full-fledged trainings, courses and workshops on topics related to MLE
- Actively contribute in the planning and implementation of school demonstration projects on MLE
- Support in creating academic content and assessments for children using principles of multilingual education and early literacy
- Contribute in developing a range of online content for children and teachers, like animated videos
- Collaborate with researchers, external partners and organizations for contributing to various MLE projects from time to time
- Actively contribute to the national policy and advocacy matters related to MLE
- Represent LLF's MLE work on various state, national and international forums
- Support in any other MLE activity, programme or intervention as and when needed

- Strong understanding of multilingual education and MLE programs
